Conditions for admission to thesis defense

The degree of Doctor of Philosophy is awarded after the successful completion of obligations described in art. 46, par. 2 of the Higher Education Act, art. 9, par. 2 of the Academic Staff Development Act in Bulgaria and its statutes of application and in accordance with the Conditions and Rules of obtaining the degree of Doctor of Philosophy stipulated in the Internal

Academic Staff Development Rules and Procedures at the South-West University "Neofit Rilski".

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Remarks on the curriculum:

1. The individual educational, research, pedagogical and other activities as described in the curriculum are defined for every individual PhD student each semester and academic year in an individual work plan, with stipulations of length, forms of assessment and validation and all other relevant information.

2. The curriculum contains all the requirements, described by the Higher Education Act the Law for the Academic Staff Development Act in Bulgaria and its statutes of application and in accordance with the Conditions and Rules of obtaining the degree of Doctor of Philosophy stipulated in the Internal Academic Staff Development Rules and Procedures at the South-West University "Neofit Rilski".

3. The curriculum allows the PhD student to meet the minimum national requirements for the scientific field.
